Volunteers (Tier I)

Steps to becoming a Tier I volunteer

1. Download, complete, and print a [Request for Livescan](#) form.
2. Take two (2) copies of the Request for Livescan form to any DOJ-approved Livescan company with photo I.D. and payment (see forms of payment below).
3. Individuals wanting to be a Volunteer (Tier I) must follow the CUSD [process for Volunteers](#) and complete the [Request to Volunteer \(Tier I\) Form](#)

Requirements of Tier I Volunteers:

- Fingerprint Clearance.
- Wear a site issued identification badge whenever you volunteer.
- Acknowledgement of [Volunteer Handbook](#).
- Sign-in at the front office when volunteering at a school site.
